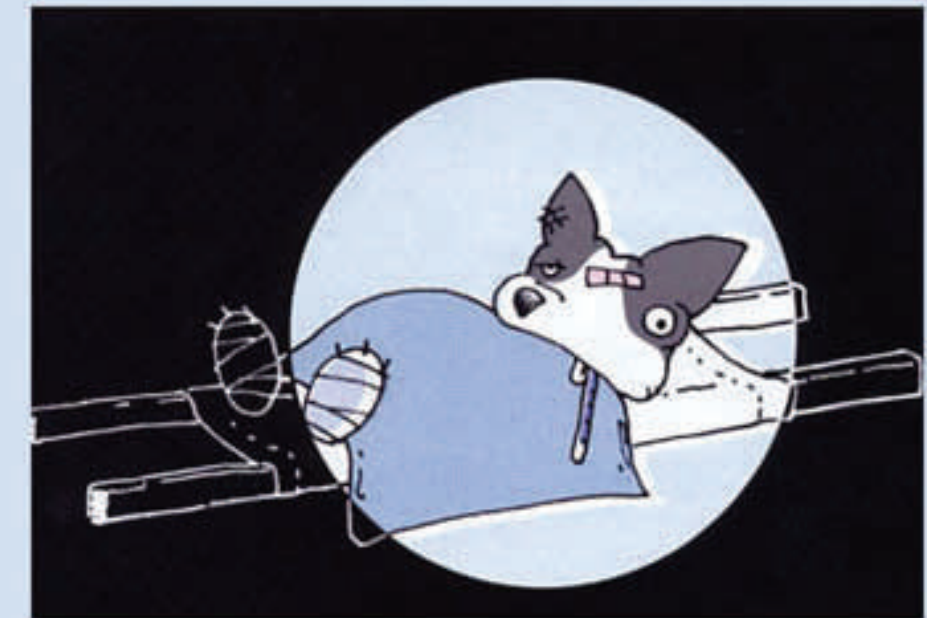


Dog Owners

Five Things to Know

Before Climbing Quandary Peak

- 🐾 Your dog should be leashed to protect it from becoming lost and from backcountry hazards such as porcupines, mountain lions, bears, and dangerous animals.
- 🐾 Watch for damage to paw pads. The top section of this trail requires traveling through rocks that are sharp and may injure your dog's pads.
- 🐾 Remember to bring plenty of water for you and your dog. Bring a zip lock bag or bowl for your dog to drink from.
- 🐾 Dog owners have abandoned their dogs on this peak because they were unprepared—don't put your dog or rescuers at risk!
- 🐾 Make sure your dog is conditioned for this trip.
