Bakers Tank Trail System

Bakers Tank Trail – #40 Aspen Grove Trail - #9133
 Mtn. Pride - #9031 Valdero Trail – #9032 Broken Wheel – #9145

Difficulty: EASY
 TO MODERATE

Trail Use: Moderate

Length: Bakers Tank Trail – 2.3 mi., Aspen Grove Trail – 0.8 mi., Mountain Pride Trail – 1.2 mi., Valdero Trail – 0.8 mi., Broken Wheel Trail – 0.5 mi.

Elevation: The lowest elevation is where the Aspen Grove meets the Boreas Pass Road at 10,000 feet. The highest point is on the Mountain Pride Trail at 11,160 feet.

Elevation Gain: 1,160 feet

Open In Winter To: X-C SKIING, SNOWSHOEING

Open In Summer To: HIKING, HORSE, MTN. BIKING

Access: Bakers Tank Trailhead

- From I-70, take Exit 203, Frisco / Breckenridge and travel south on Highway 9 through Frisco and Breckenridge (approximately 11 miles).
- At the traffic light near the southern end of town, turn left on the Boreas Pass Road (County Road 10) and proceed about 3.5 miles.
- The trailhead is on the left near the end of the pavement.
- In the summer, you can park here or drive about 2.5 miles on the unpaved road to the southeastern end of Bakers Tank Trail (at Bakers Tank).

Trail Highlights:

- The trails offer views of Breckenridge Ski Area and the Ten Mile Range.
- The trails pass through stands of lodgepole pine and aspen.
- Bakers tank is a historic site along the steam locomotive route used for re-supply
- This area has beautiful aspen colors in the fall.
- The Boreas Pass Road continues into Park County.
- Valdero is the name of a nearby historic mining community.

Important information:

- Mountain bikes may only be used on trails marked with a mountain bike symbol. If there is no sign, it is closed to that use.
- Dog owners - Please be considerate of other trail users. Keep your dog in sight and when you encounter others, call the dog to your side until they pass. Use a stick to remove dog feces from the trail.
