Willow Creek Trail System

Cah-nahv Trail – #600 South Willowbrook Trail – #9080
 North Willow Creek Trail – #9084 Three Peaks Trail – #9080

Difficulty: EASY TO MODERATE

Trail Use: Moderate

Length: Cah-nahv Trail – 0.2 mi., South Willowbrook Trail – 0.7 mi., North Willow Creek Trail – 0.8 mi., Three Peaks Trail – 0.5 mi.

Elevation: The lowest elevation is at the Willowbrook Trailhead at 8,840 feet. The highest point is at northern junction with the Gore Range Trail at 9,600 feet.

Elevation Gain: 760 feet

Open In Winter To: X-C SKIING, SNOWSHOEING

Open In Summer To: HIKING, HORSE,

Access: Willow Brook Trailhead

- From I-70, take Exit 205, Silverthorne and travel north on Highway 9 approximately 1.9 miles.
- Turn left onto Willowbrook Road. Proceed about 0.7 miles to the trailhead at the end of the road.

Trail Highlights:

- These trails access the Eagles Nest Wilderness and the Gore Range Trail
- The North Willow Creek Trail and South Willowbrook Trail follow the north and south forks of Willow Creek.
- The South Willowbrook Trail accesses the Mesa Cortina Trail System
- Cah-nahv is the Ute word for Willow. The Ute people were the original inhabitants of this area.

Important information:

- **DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES IN THE EAGLES NEST WILDERNESS.**
- Read the trailhead kiosk for important wilderness regulations and safety requirements.
- There is no overnight parking at the Willowbrook Trailhead.
- Mountain bikes are not allowed on this trail system.
